


Two of the Compass Guide books are now available in Spanish

Final Three Publications from the BEATS Research Programme

Although the BEATS Research Programme (2013-2023) officially closed in September 2023, the BEATS Research Team continued finalising the delivery of remaining BEATS research outputs.

The final three BEATS articles were published during the August-October 2024 period. That completes the publication of all scientific journal articles planned to be delivered by the BEATS investigators and research students – with a total of 46 scientific journal articles published reporting the BEATS findings:

 Adding a cultural lens to active transport initiatives: Māori and Pacific adolescents' perceptions of transport to school, led by the BEATS investigator, Dr Anna Rolleston;

- Adolescents' unhealthy snacking behaviour during the school journey and the association with transport modes and food outlets along the school route, led by the BEATS PhD student Margaretha Liliana Situmorang; and
- Adolescents' perceptions of food outlets in the school neighbourhood and their unhealthy snacking behaviour on the way to and from school, also led by the BEATS PhD student Margaretha Liliana Situmorang.

Several other scientific articles led by BEATS collaborators have been submitted as well and currently in review.
